TIP of Greater Portland is a group of specially-trained volunteers who provide immediate emotional and practical support and resources to survivors of traumatic events. TIP Volunteers are dispatched through the 911 system to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, homicide, suicide, accidental, infant deaths, industrial accidents, sexual assaults, overdoses, violent crime, and other traumatic incidents). We serve Cumberland, Falmouth, Gorham, Portland, Scarborough, South Portland, Westbrook, Windham and Maine Medical Center.
